❖ Albany County, in partnership with the Laramie Rivers Conservation District and the City of Laramie will once again offer residents of Albany County an opportunity to dispose of tires, refrigerator/freezers, batteries and general trash and junk items, free of charge.

On **Saturday, August 14th, from 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.**, the City Landfill will be open to County residents for disposal of trash, junk, tires, appliances, and batteries, etc.

Additionally, on **Saturday, August 14th**, dump trucks will be located at the below locations to haul your trash and junk to the landfill for you!!

8:00 a.m. - 8:45 a.m.

Lake Hattie (Boat ramp parking lot) and  
Woods Landing (Parking lot)

11:00 a.m. - 11:45 a.m.

Centennial (East of Trading Post)



The Town of Rock River will have a dump truck at the County Shop all day Friday, August 13<sup>th</sup> and until 2:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 14<sup>th</sup>. They will be collecting and hauling **TIRES ONLY**. All other items will need to be transported to the landfill by the owner.



**\*\*\*No early or late drop-offs\*\*\***

Tires and refrigerator/freezers and batteries must be hauled to the landfill by the owner as County trucks will not haul them from collection sites. **No household hazardous wastes will be accepted.** (Paint, oil, herbicides, pesticides, etc. – you may call the City of Laramie Hazardous Waste Program at 721-5279, M-F from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. to schedule a drop off of these chemicals)

**\*\*ONLY CAR AND LIGHT TRUCK TIRES WILL BE ACCEPTED\*\***

**\*\*\*NO TIRES FROM DEALERS\*\*\***
