## **REGULAR AGENDA**

5. Proclamation designating September 20, 2013 as Edward and Jane Ivinson Day in Laramie.

MOTION by Chesnut, seconded by Kennedy to APPROVE the Proclamation below proclaiming September 20, 2013 as Edward and Jane Ivinson Day:

**WHEREAS**, Edward and Jane Ivinson were among the first families to settle in Laramie, Wyoming, in 1868 and immediately began to work to better their community—spiritually, socially and economically;

**WHEREAS**, with the welfare of the children of her town being her utmost concern, Jane Ivinson led the effort to establish the first public school, the first Sunday school, and the first church in Laramie, Wyoming, and was a charter member of the local chapter of the Rebekahs service organization;

**WHEREAS**, Edward Ivinson established the first permanent bank and several other successful businesses in Laramie, Wyoming;

**WHEREAS**, Edward Ivinson served his community as mayor of Laramie; was elected as Treasurer of the Board of Trustees for the University of Wyoming; was a member of the commission that established the location for and approved the construction of the Wyoming Territorial Penitentiary, the first Albany County Courthouse, and local commercial buildings; and was Noble Grant of the local chapter of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows service organization;

**WHEREAS**, Edward Ivinson determined that his early successful business endeavors were only possible due to the trust the citizens of the community placed in him, he dedicated his later life to philanthropic works to repay the trust of his community; Edward Ivinson provided the funds to build the original Ivinson Memorial Hospital, to finish the construction of the towers of St. Matthew's Cathedral, to ensure the Cathedral Home for Children could occupy larger and more suitable quarters, and to construct a memorial to Albany County and University of Wyoming veterans of World War I;

**WHEREAS**, Edward Ivinson created a perpetual trust in honor of his wife to build and maintain the Ivinson Home for Ladies, and donated his elegant mansion to the Episcopal Church for use as a school for girls (that today houses the Laramie Plains Museum).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Albany County Commissioners, do hereby proclaim 20 September 2013 as Edward and Jane Ivinson Day in Laramie and encourage all citizens, businesses, public and private agencies, religious and educational institutions to join in observing the day in honor of Edward and Jane Ivinson.


