

Resolution 2017-006

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT BOUNDARY BOARD FOR ALBANY COUNTY, WYOMING SHALL NOT ANNUALLY MEET UNLESS THE ALBANY COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1 PROPOSES CHANGES TO ITS GEOGRAPHICAL BOUNDARIES IN THE PROCEEDING YEAR.

Whereas, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 21-6-203, the County Assessor, the Board of County Commissioners and the County Treasurer for Albany County shall constitute the School District Boundary Board.

Whereas, the School District Boundary Board has the authority to determine when it is in the benefit of the educational needs of the pupils and with the consent of the School District Board to organize or reorganize a school district or alter and change the geographical boundaries of any school district.

Whereas, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 21-6-205, the School District Boundary Board shall meet in the first quarter of each calendar year to elect officers.

Whereas, there is only one school district encompassing the entire Albany County and it is not necessary to annually meet in the first quarter of each calendar year unless the Albany County School District No. 1 pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 21-6-226 proposes changes to its geographical boundaries in the preceding year.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF THE COUNTY OF ALBANY, WYOMING RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the foregoing recitals are incorporated in and made a part of this resolution by this reference.

Section 2. That, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 21-6-226, the School District Boundary Board for Albany County shall not annually meet in the first quarter of each calendar year unless the Albany County School District No. 1 proposes changes to its geographical boundaries in the preceding year.




