

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-18

A RESOLUTION ALLOWING MINORS WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT TO ENTER OR REMAIN IN THE DINING AREA OR WAITING AREA OR LICENSED ROOM WHERE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE SOLD

WHEREAS, W.S. §12-5-203 allows the Board of County Commissioners, as the local licensing authority, to regulate the sale of alcoholic and malt beverages within Albany County, Wyoming;

WHEREAS, pursuant to W. S. §12-5-203, a local licensing authority may allow persons under the age of eighteen (18) years to enter or remain in a dining or waiting area of a licensed room where alcoholic beverages are sold no later than 10:00 p.m. as long as the dining or waiting area is part of the licensed room and the minor is accompanied by an adult.

WHEREAS, the Wyoming Liquor Commission has requested from the County Commissioners any resolutions or regulations enacted by the County Commissioners pursuant to this statute;

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners have not previously considered this issue but desire to enact such provision;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board, as the local licensing authority, hereby allows persons under the age of eighteen (18) to enter or remain in the licensed rooms or rooms where alcoholic beverages are sold when accompanied by his parent or guardian who is at least eighteen (18) years of age and the licensed room is for the sale of alcoholic or malt beverages for off-premises consumption and separate from any licensed room for on-premises consumption, or in a dining or waiting area with an adult not later than 10:00 p.m. if the dining or waiting area is part of the licensed room.
