PUBLIC HEARING

Amended Liquor Control Regulations

Several residents provided comments to the Board regarding the Amended Liquor Control Regulations raising concerns such as events within the County involving more than 250 attendees from the public where alcoholic beverages will be allowed, permitted or served for an entertainment, cultural, recreational, educational, political, religious or sporting nature, the terminology of "private property", enforcement, special event regulation versus a liquor control regulation and whether or not these regulations apply only when liquor is involved.

5. **Adjourn.**


