**ORDINANCE TO AMEND 18-204  
RESIDENTIAL, BUSINESS AND COMMERCIAL FEES.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF ROCK RIVER:**

**SECTION 1.**

18-204—Fees—Fees for the use of the Solid Waste Transfer Station shall be established by the Town Council from time to time.

Solid Waste Transfer Fees will be amended on the date of February 1, 2021 and with the fees to be as follows, with the Town reserving the right to determine and administer rate changes from time to time as permitted by law:

**SECTION 2.**

**FEES**

**RESIDENTIAL:** Household Garbage – Required to be bagged - \$28.00 effective October 05, 2015.

**BUSINESS GARBAGE** – Required to be bagged - \$46.00 effective October 05, 2015.

**COMMERCIAL OR CONSTRUCTION** - Pickup Load – No Racks - \$15.00 per load

With Racks - \$30.00 per load

Dumpster Rentals Per Load: \$280.00

Time limit to have in customer’s possession: 1 month, after the first month there shall be a fee of \$100.00 per month.

ORDINANCE: 19-205

INTRODUCED BY: Council

ORDINANCE TO AMEND 19-205  
RESIDENTIAL AND BUSINESS FEES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF ROCK RIVER:

SECTION 1.

19-205---Same--Contents; Fees---The permit shall state the name and address of the person making the connection or excavation, the property to be served, the location of the tap to the municipal sewer main and the size of the tap. No permit shall be issued unless the fees prescribed by the Town of Rock River are tendered with the application for a permit. Such fees shall be as are established from time to time by the Town Council; hence, sewer tap fee is established at \$1000.00 per tap to be installed within the time period of three (3) months upon approval of permit application.

Clark made a motion to accept the first reading of ordinance 19-205, seconded by White, all ayes, motion carried.

ORDINANCE 25-612

Introduced by Council

ORDINANCE TO AMEND 25-612 CHARGE FOR HOOK-UP

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF ROCK RIVER:

Section 1. That Ordinance 25-612 read as follows:

25-612-- Charge for hook-up - Residential tap-- A charge shall be made for each hook-up connection to the existing water lines, such charge to be (determined from time to time by the Town Council and set forth in special ordinance, hence, water tap fee is established at \$2000.00 per ¾ inch tap and \$2100.00 per 1 inch tap to be installed within the time period of three (3) months upon approval of permit application. The Town will not provide a tap to a residence that is larger than 1 inch. The Town has the right to update cost from time to time as the market prices change.

White made a motion to accept the first reading of ordinance 25-612, seconded by Bowers, all ayes, motion carried.

The mayor reminded the council that the town hall will be closed on Thurs and Fri December 24 and 25 for Christmas and Thurs and Fri December 31 and January 1 for New Years,

With no further business White made a motion to adjourn seconded by Voss all ayes, meeting adjourned at 7:37 pm.
