Dear Aircraft Owner:

If your aircraft is held and used solely for personal or family use and therefore exempt from personal property taxes, **complete this affidavit, sign and return** to our office no later than March 01.

If you do not claim your exemption by returning this letter, your aircraft will be taxed as business property.

All information comes directly from FAA aircraft registration records; if any listings are incorrect, you will need to update your information with them. General aircraft registration information is printed on the back of this letter. Please refer your questions directly to the FAA, as we cannot make corrections to your aircraft registration through this office.
